

Cyber Profits Privacy Policy

Here at Cyber Profits, LLC (“Cyber Profits,” the “Company” or “we”) we want to ensure that you have a clear understanding of how the Company collects, uses, and shares your personal information. These terms are designed to provide you an opportunity to familiarize yourself with our privacy practices and the specific information that may apply to you.

Information we collect

The Company collects personal information to help us service your accounts and to deliver an exceptional experience. The kind of information we collect depends on the products and services you apply for and what we need to maintain your accounts. We do not collect more information than is needed to provide you with the products and services you signed up for and/or to process any payments for such products and services. Additionally, some service providers may share your information with us for specific purposes, such as to verify your identity and to protect your accounts, to process payments and financial information.

Some of the information we collect includes, but may not be limited to the following:

- Your name, address, billing address, email, financial information, contact information, and information concerning the actions that you perform while logged into your account on our website or mobile application.
- We may collect certain biometric information about you, such as imagery of the iris, retina, fingerprint, face, hand, palm, vein patterns, and voice recordings, from which an identifier template, such as a faceprint, a minutiae template, or a voiceprint, can be extracted, and keystroke patterns or rhythms, gait patterns, or rhythms, and sleep, health, or exercise data that contain identifying information. We are required to collect this information to meet certain legal obligations and have a legitimate interest in doing so and preventing fraud.
- If you are signing on as an entity, then we may collect information regarding your employees with whom we may interact.
- We use cookies and clear GIFs. “Cookies” are small pieces of information that a website sends to a computer’s hard drive while a website is viewed. This is intended to make our website and mobile applications operate efficiently in order to provide you with the best services and experience.
- We may place tracking technology on our website that collects analytics, records how you interact with our website, or allows us to participate in behavior-based advertising. This means that a third party uses technology (e.g., a cookie) to collect information about your use of our website so that they can report analytics to us or provide advertising about products and services tailored to your interests. That third party might also collect information over time and across different websites in order to serve advertisements on our website or other websites. If consents are required by law, we will seek such consent from you.

- In order to ensure that you are a legitimate user and a person of age, and to attempt to prevent fraudulent and illegal activity, we may collect other personal information such as date of birth, social security, gender, race and/or location.
- If you receive an email from us, we may use certain tools to capture data related to when you open our message, click on any links or banners it contains and make purchases.
- If you provide us feedback or contact us for support, we will collect your name and email address, as well as any other content that you send to us, in order to reply.
- In order to better understand how you interact with us through your mobile device and to better your experience, we collect information from your mobile device such as unique identifying information broadcast from your device when visiting our website or when visiting one of our stores.
- If you participate in a survey, sweepstake or contest, we collect information that you provide through the survey, sweepstake or contest. If the survey, sweepstake or contest is provided by a third-party service provider, the third party's privacy policy applies to the collection, use, and disclosure of your information.
- We use technology to monitor how you interact with our website. This may include which links you click on, or information that you type into our online forms. This may also include information about your device or browser. We have a legitimate interest in understanding how you interact with our website to better improve it, and in understanding your preferences and interests to select offerings that you might find most useful. We also have a legitimate interest in detecting and preventing fraud.
- We collect information, including your browser type, operating system, Internet Protocol (IP) address (a number that is automatically assigned to a computer when the internet is used), domain name, click-activity, referring website, and/or a date/time stamp for visitors. We have a legitimate interest in monitoring our networks and the visitors to our websites. Among other things, it helps us understand which of our services is the most popular.
- We collect any information you provide us with via email, mail, voice, or any other means. Our interest is to better our products and services, as well as your experience using our website and mobile application.
- If you apply for a job posting, or become an employee of the Company, we collect information necessary to conduct a background check, process your application or to retain you as an employee. This may include, among other things, your Social Security Number. Providing this information is required for employment.

Purpose of Collecting Information

The reasons we collect personal data and under certain circumstances provide it to third parties include, but may not be limited to (1) operate and deliver the products and services you have requested; (2) to inform you of other products or services available from the Company and its affiliates; (3) to identify you when you visit our website and mobile application and use our products or services; (4) to improve our services and product offerings; (5) to conduct analytics; (6) to process payments; (7) to communicate with you; (8) to detect and protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, including violations of our Terms of Use, other

policies, security incidents, and harm to the rights, property, or safety of our company and our users, employees, or others; (9) to debug, identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality of our website and services; (10) to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, to establish or exercise our rights, and to defend against a legal claim; (11) for internal administrative purposes, as well as to manage our relationships; (12) to ensure proper account creation, ease of use, reliability, security and/or functionality of our products and services; and (13) for such other and further purposes as you may consent to from time to time.

How we collect information

We collect information from and about you in a variety of ways, which may include but is not limited to:

1. Directly from you when you provide it to us during registration or account set-up, when you sign up to your account, when you communicate with us by phone, electronically or by any other means;
2. Through the use of cookies, server logs, and other similar technologies when you interact with our website or mobile application, through promotional material, advertisements and emails; and
3. From other sources such as Company affiliates, business partners, service providers, online social media networks, and other third parties, or from publicly available sources.

Information we share

In addition to the foregoing terms and policies, we may also share information in the following situations: (1) with our current or future affiliates, parent company, sister companies, subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under common control; (2) with any entity or person that acquires, or plans to acquire, our company, business, or our assets; (3) in response to subpoenas, warrants, or court orders, or in connection with any legal process, or to comply with applicable laws; (4) in order to establish or exercise our rights, to defend against a legal claim, to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding possible illegal activities, suspected fraud, safety of person or property, or a violation of our policies, or to comply with your request for the shipment of products to or the provision of services by a third-party intermediary; (5) if you post or provide information on our website or other public forums; (6) with third-party service providers, such technical support, surveys, process payments, fulfilling orders, website and mobile application administration; (7) with other simulated trading platforms and/or related affiliates in order to detect and protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity or violations of our Terms of Use, and other policies; (8) when you give us consent to share such information; and/or (9) to comply with legal and regulatory obligations.

We may also share limited information for targeted advertisement. If you do not wish to be included in any such targeted advertisement, you must notify the Company in writing. Please visit our website for contact and notice information.

Cookies and other online technologies

Our websites, mobile applications and advertisements may use "cookies" or other technologies to make our sites and applications work like we believe you expect them to such as providing features or services that you have accessed or requested, or for our advertising purposes. You may be able to manage cookies and online tracking through your browser or device operating system. However, optimal functionality may be impacted if cookies are disabled.

Cookies are small pieces of text sent to your browser by a website you visit. They help that website remember information about your visit, which can both make it easier to visit the site again and make the site more useful to you. Similar technologies, including unique identifiers used to identify an application or device, pixel tags, and local storage, can perform the same function.

Cookies and similar technologies used for functionality allow you to access features that are fundamental to a service. Things considered fundamental to a service include remembering choices and preferences, like your choice of language; storing information relating to your session, such as the content of a shopping cart; enabling features or performing tasks requested by you; and product optimizations that help maintain and improve that service.

Some browsers incorporate a "Do Not Track" setting. We currently do not respond to DNT Signals, except for signals received from California. Also, some U.S. states and other jurisdictions, including California, have laws that provide you with additional means of limiting our use of such information. Security

We take security very seriously. We use reasonable measures to help protect against unauthorized access to or alteration to your personal information. We also take measures to ensure against loss of information, theft, misuse and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction. You should understand that no data storage system or transmission of data over the Internet or any other public network can be guaranteed to be 100 percent secure. Please note that information collected by third parties may not have the same security protections as information you submit to us, and we are not responsible for protecting the security of such information.

If you wish to lodge a complaint on how we have handled your request, you may contact us directly.

Where we process your personal information based upon consent, you may revoke your consent. Please note, if you revoke your consent for the processing of personal information then we may no longer be able to provide you with our products and services.

California residents are entitled once a year, free of charge, to request and obtain certain information regarding our disclosure, if any, of certain categories of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes in the preceding calendar year. We do not share personal information with third parties for their own direct marketing purposes.

Changes and amendments

The foregoing terms and policies are subject to change at our own discretion. The Company reserves the right to amend its terms and policies from time to time and as needed or necessary. If there is a material change to our terms and policies, we will notify you of such changes. It is also your responsibility to make sure you regularly access and review the Company's Terms and Conditions, Privacy Policies, and other policies for any changes or amendments that may impact you.
