

Terms of Service

Jibzi Systems — Software & Commercial Services Agreement

1. Introduction & Acceptance of Terms

These Terms of Service ("Agreement") govern the purchase, access, and use of all standalone software products, point-of-sale applications, digital tools, and related documentation (collectively, the "Software") provided by **Jibzi Systems** ("Company", "we", "us", or "our").

By purchasing, downloading, installing, or activating any software product from Jibzi Systems via Whop or any authorized channel, you ("Customer", "Licensee", or "User") agree to be legally bound by this Agreement. If you are entering into this Agreement on behalf of a company or legal entity, you represent that you have the authority to bind such entity to these terms.

2. Software Licensing & Scope of Use

Upon receipt of full payment, Jibzi Systems grants you a non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable, perpetual (lifetime) license to install, execute, and use the compiled binary of the software on the designated number of physical hardware units (workstations/machines) specified in your purchased tier.

- **Single Machine Binding:** Unless an enterprise multi-seat license is explicitly purchased, each lifetime license is cryptographically bound to a single physical device via hardware Machine ID.
- **Permitted Commercial Use:** You are granted the right to use the software for your internal business operations, retail transactions, customer management, inventory accounting, and invoice generation.
- **Prohibited Restrictions:** You shall not copy, modify, distribute, sublicense, rent, lease, decompile, reverse engineer, disassemble, or derive source code from any portion of the software.

3. Offline Architecture & Data Sovereignty

Jibzi Systems software is engineered with an offline-first architecture. All databases (including SQLite local files), customer ledgers, transaction records, inventory numbers, and financial data reside exclusively on your local storage environment. The Customer retains 100% ownership, responsibility, and custody of all business data created using the software.

4. Customer Responsibilities & System Requirements

The Customer is solely responsible for:

- Maintaining compatible hardware, supported operating system environments (Windows 10/11 64-bit), and peripheral equipment (printers, barcode scanners).
- Conducting regular and automated backups of local SQLite databases and exported Excel records to external storage media.
- Safeguarding local administrative access passwords and activation credentials.

5. Intellectual Property Rights

All intellectual property rights, titles, copyrights, trade secrets, software architecture, UI layouts, graphic assets, and source codes associated with Jibzi Systems products remain the sole and exclusive property of Jibzi Systems. This Agreement does not sell or transfer ownership of the software.

6. Limitation of Liability & Disclaimers

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, the software is provided on an "AS IS" and "AS AVAILABLE" basis without warranties of any kind, whether express or implied. In no event shall Jibzi Systems or its developers be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, special, or exemplary damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, data corruption, hardware failure, or business interruption arising out of the use or inability to use the software.

7. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws governing commercial software transactions. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with these terms shall first be addressed through good-faith informal negotiation through official customer support channels.
