Who provides the service

Your purchase

Discovery is one research engagement:

- **US Discovery: \$600 USD**, for communities within the United States.
- **Discovery with international coverage: \$900 USD total**, for communities outside the United States, within it, or a mix of both.

Each is a one-time payment, with no subscription. Both cover up to three recommended communities in total. Applicable taxes and any currency conversion are shown at checkout.

How we agree on the search

After purchase, complete the written intake. Share the details that matter to your decision, including firm limits, spending limits, and what you are still unsure about. I'll review your answers and ask follow-up questions.

Before the location research starts, I'll send you a brief to confirm. It records the requirements, priorities, and tradeoffs that will guide the search. You can start with a few places in mind or none. Your confirmation establishes the scope; I'll remain responsible for the quality of the research.

What you receive

You'll receive written findings with sources and a map. For each recommended community, I'll identify a residential area to explore and assess whether suitable housing within your budget and access to the places and services you need look feasible. I'll explain the reasons for the recommendation, the compromises, and useful things to check during a visit.

If fewer than three places fit, I'll explain why. When no place meets all your requirements, the findings may explain the conflict and identify alternatives that depend on a compromise. I'll make those conditions clear.

International research includes checking published residency requirements to identify plausible options and obstacles. It does not determine your individual legal eligibility. Where a recommendation depends on a complex eligibility question, I'll identify what needs confirmation from a qualified professional.

Timing

Allow two to three weeks for the research after you confirm your brief. I'll give you a delivery date when we agree the brief. Completing the intake, answering follow-up questions, and confirming the brief happen before this research period.

If I need information from you to continue, I'll explain what is missing and how it affects delivery. If I expect to miss the agreed date for another reason, I'll tell you and discuss how to resolve the delay.

Messages and optional calls

We can complete the engagement through private Whop messages. One 45-minute discovery call and one 30-minute recommendation review call are included if you want them. You choose and book an available time. Calls are optional; working in writing does not itself delay the research.

Calls take place by appointment. There are no missed-call fees. If you'd like additional consultations, we'll agree on the price before you book.

Follow-up and adjustments

After delivery, send your questions and reactions together so I can consider them as one round of adjustments. This can include revised findings or replacement suggestions within the confirmed brief. The optional review call can help us discuss this same round.

If your plans change enough to need a new search, we can discuss a separate engagement. I'll correct any errors or missed requirements you had disclosed without using your adjustment round.

If I have not heard from you after 14 days, I'll leave the case inactive until you're ready to continue. You can return later to complete the calls or adjustments you have not used, through normal availability. The remaining work follows the original brief. Location information can change after the research date; a fresh location search is a separate engagement.

Service boundaries

Discovery helps you identify places worth considering. It does not include finding a property or job, arranging viewings, securing school admission or healthcare, booking a trip, handling a move, or providing legal, tax, immigration, or financial advice.

I'll explain the evidence behind each recommendation and what to assess in person. Housing and service availability can change, and residence permission depends on the relevant authorities. A visit helps you assess how a place feels before you make a commitment.
