This Privacy Policy ("Policy") describes how Triton Trades LLC ("we," "us," or "our"), collects, uses, shares, and protects your personal information when you access or use our digital educational services related to trading and market strategies (the "Services"). We are committed to protecting your privacy and complying with applicable data protection laws.

1. Information We Collect

We do not collect sensitive personal information (e.g., social security numbers, health data) unless required for specific features, and we do not intentionally collect data from children under 18.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to provide, improve, and personalize the Services:

- To manage your account, process payments, and grant access to educational content, tools, and community features.
- To communicate with you, including sending updates, newsletters, or responses to inquiries.
- To analyze usage patterns and improve the Services (e.g., via aggregated data).
- For marketing purposes, such as promoting our offerings or using your testimonials (with your consent where required).
- To comply with legal obligations, enforce our Terms, and prevent fraud or misuse.

We do not use your information for automated decision-making that significantly affects you.

3. How We Share Your Information

We share your information only as necessary:

- **Service Providers:** With third parties who process data on our behalf under strict confidentiality agreements.
- **Affiliates and Partners:** If you use affiliate links, limited data may be shared with those third parties.
- **Legal Requirements:** If required by law, subpoena, or to protect our rights, safety, or property.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your information may be transferred.

We do not sell your personal information to third parties.

4. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your information from unauthorized access, loss, or alteration. However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.
