1. About Us

Summit Group Digital Pty Ltd operates under the brand names Summit and Summit Markets, and on the Whop platform as summit-markets. References to "we", "us", "our", or "Summit" in this Policy refer to Summit Group Digital Pty Ltd trading as Summit and Summit Markets.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and disclose your personal information when you use our Services. We are committed to handling your information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles.

2. Information We Collect

2.1 Account and Identity Information

- Name, email address, and username provided at registration.
- Payment and billing information processed and stored by Whop. We do not store card details.
- Discord user ID and username when you access our Discord community.

2.2 Usage and Technical Information

- Access logs, activity within our platforms, and feature usage data.
- Device type, browser, IP address, and approximate location data collected automatically.
- Cookie and analytics data as described in Section 6.

2.3 Communications

- Any information you provide when contacting us for support or enquiries.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use your personal information to:

- Provide, manage, and improve your access to our Services and memberships.
- Process payments and manage billing through Whop.
- Communicate with you about your account, updates, and policy changes.
- Enforce our Terms of Service and protect the security of our Services.
- Comply with applicable legal obligations.
- Send marketing communications where you have opted in. You may opt out at any time.

4. Legal Bases for Processing

- Contract performance: to fulfil your membership and provide the Services you have purchased.
- Legitimate interests: to operate, secure, and improve our Services, prevent fraud, and enforce our policies.
- Legal obligation: to comply with applicable laws and regulations.
- Consent: for optional marketing communications and any other processing requiring your express consent.

5. Sharing and Disclosure

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties. We may share your information with:

- Service providers: Whop, Discord, TradingView, and hosting and infrastructure providers, solely to deliver the Services.
- Professional advisers: legal, accounting, and compliance professionals where required.
- Law enforcement or regulatory bodies: where required by law or to protect the rights and safety of ourselves and others.

Any third party service providers are required to handle your data in accordance with applicable privacy laws and our instructions.

6. Cookies and Tracking

Our web based platforms may use cookies and similar tracking technologies to maintain your session and authentication state, collect analytics data to understand how the Services are used, and improve performance and user experience. You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings. Disabling cookies may limit some functionality of our Services.

7. Data Security

We implement reasonable technical and organisational safeguards to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. No method of electronic transmission or storage is 100% secure and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

8. Data Retention

We retain your personal information for as long as necessary to provide the Services and comply with our legal obligations. Specifically:

- Account and subscription data: retained for the duration of your membership plus 7 years for tax and accounting purposes.
- Support communications: retained for 2 years after the matter is resolved.
- Analytics data: retained in aggregated or anonymised form indefinitely.

You may request deletion of your personal data at any time, subject to our legal obligations to retain certain records.

9. Your Rights

Subject to applicable law, you have the right to:

- Access the personal information we hold about you.
- Correct inaccurate or incomplete information.
- Request deletion of your personal information where legally permissible.
- Opt out of marketing communications at any time.
- Lodge a complaint with the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner at www.oaic.gov.au if you believe we have breached the Australian Privacy Principles.

10. International Data Transfers

Our third party service providers may process or store your data outside of Australia, including in the United States. Where this occurs, we take reasonable steps to ensure your information is handled in a manner consistent with the Australian Privacy Principles.

12. Updates to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices or legal obligations. We will notify you of material changes via email or a prominent notice on our platforms. The effective date at the top of this document reflects the most recent update.

13. General Provisions

If any provision of this Policy is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect. This Policy is governed by the laws of New South Wales, Australia.
