Retention period: The data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required for the purpose, unless statutory retention obligations exist.

4. Cookies

This website uses technically necessary cookies to provide basic functions such as form protection or language selection. On your first visit, a cookie banner will appear through which you can manage your consent.

Legal bases:

- For necessary cookies: Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR (legitimate interest)
- For all other cookies: Art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR (consent)

You can change or revoke your cookie settings at any time.

5. Server Log Files

When the website is accessed, the hosting provider automatically collects the following data:

- IP address (anonymized where applicable)
- Date and time of access
- Pages accessed
- Browser type and version
- Operating system

This data is used for technical security and error analysis.

Legal basis: Art. 6 (1) lit. f GDPR

Retention period: Automated deletion after a maximum of 30 days

6. Your Rights

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights:

- Right to information about your stored data (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification of inaccurate data (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure of your data (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to withdraw consent (Art. 7 (3) GDPR)

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority in the EU Member State of your residence, place of work, or the place of the alleged infringement (Art. 77 GDPR).
