This Privacy Policy explains how 8050 Endeavors LLC, a United States corporation, collects, uses, shares, and protects personal information when you visit our website, purchase or access our paid Trading Psychology course, communicate with us, or interact with our related services.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect personal information that you provide directly to us, information generated automatically when you use our website or course platform, and information from third-party service providers that help us operate our business.

Information you provide

- Name, email address, billing address, account login details, and course registration information.
- Payment-related information submitted during checkout. We do not intentionally store full credit card numbers; payment information is typically processed by our payment processor.
- Customer support messages, survey responses, testimonials, reviews, coaching intake responses, or other information you choose to submit.

Information collected automatically

- Device information, browser type, IP address, operating system, referring pages, pages viewed, course activity, access times, and approximate location derived from IP address.
- Usage data such as lesson progress, login history, downloads, quiz or assessment activity, and interactions with emails or course materials.

- Cookies, pixels, analytics tools, and similar technologies used to operate the site, remember preferences, improve performance, measure engagement, and support marketing.

2. How We Use Personal Information

We use personal information to provide and improve the course, process transactions, manage customer accounts, communicate with students, protect our business, and comply with legal obligations.

- To create and manage your account and course access.
- To process payments, confirm purchases, and maintain transaction records.
- To deliver course content, updates, support, administrative notices, and service-related communications.
- To personalize the student experience and improve course materials, website performance, and customer support.
- To send marketing emails, newsletters, promotions, or educational content where permitted by law. You may unsubscribe from marketing emails at any time.
- To detect, prevent, and respond to fraud, security incidents, unauthorized access, misuse of the course, or violations of our terms.
- To comply with tax, accounting, legal, regulatory, and recordkeeping requirements.

3. No-Refund Policy and Payments

The course is sold on a no-refund basis. This Privacy Policy explains how personal information is handled; it does not replace your Terms of Sale, Terms of Use, checkout disclosures, or refund policy. Your no-refund terms should be presented clearly before purchase and kept separate from privacy disclosures.

4. How We Share Personal Information

We may share personal information with service providers and business partners that help us operate the course and website, including payment processors, course hosting platforms, email service providers, analytics providers, customer support tools, security providers, accountants, legal advisors, and contractors.

We may also disclose information when required by law, to protect our rights or the rights of others, to enforce our agreements, to prevent fraud or abuse, or in connection with a

merger, acquisition, financing, restructuring, sale of assets, or similar business transaction.

We do not sell personal information for money. If we use advertising or analytics tools that may be considered a “sale,” “sharing,” or targeted advertising under certain privacy laws, eligible users may have the right to opt out as described below.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We may use cookies, pixels, tags, analytics tools, and similar technologies to operate our website, keep you logged in, remember preferences, analyze traffic, measure marketing performance, and improve the course experience. You can adjust browser settings to block or delete cookies, but some features may not work properly.

6. Data Retention

We retain personal information for as long as reasonably necessary to provide the course, maintain business records, resolve disputes, enforce agreements, comply with tax and legal obligations, and protect our rights. Retention periods may vary depending on the type of information and the purpose for which it is used.

7. Your Privacy Choices and Rights

Depending on where you live, you may have rights to request access to personal information we hold about you, correction of inaccurate information, deletion of certain information, restriction or objection to certain processing, portability of your information, withdrawal of consent, and opt out of certain targeted advertising, sale, or sharing activities.

California residents may have additional rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act, as amended, including the right to know, delete, correct, opt out of sale or sharing, limit certain uses of sensitive personal information, and be free from discrimination for exercising privacy rights if the law applies to our business.

Individuals located in the European Economic Area, United Kingdom, or similar jurisdictions may have rights under applicable privacy laws, including rights relating to lawful basis, international transfers, access, correction, deletion, restriction, objection, portability, and complaints to a supervisory authority.

8. Security

We use reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational measures designed to protect personal information. However, no website, course platform, payment system, or storage method is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

9. Children's Privacy

Our paid Trading Psychology course is not directed to children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under 13, we will take reasonable steps to delete it.

10. International Users

If you access the course from outside the United States, your personal information may be transferred to, stored in, or processed in the United States or other countries where our service providers operate. Those countries may have privacy laws that differ from the laws of your location.

11. Third-Party Websites and Platforms
