## Content Opportunity Map Pilot - Privacy Policy

EFFECTIVE JULY 18, 2026

The seller is the verified individual operating the CAST OUT AI product on Whop (the "Seller"). The Seller identity and contact details are the details displayed by Whop at checkout and on the customer's receipt. Order support uses the included Whop Chat. Effective date: July 18, 2026.

### 1. Information collected

The pilot collects only information reasonably needed to qualify, perform, deliver, support, and document an order: customer name and email; business or public profile name; primary offer, audience, market, and authorized public-source links; customer-supplied facts, restrictions, corrections, and approvals; and order, payment, receipt, refund, support, and delivery records generated by Whop and the Seller.

Customers must not submit passwords, full payment-card numbers outside Whop, health records, government identification numbers, tax identifiers, or other unnecessary sensitive personal information.

### 2. Uses

Information is used to evaluate qualification, perform and deliver the fixed-scope service, communicate about the order, correct errors, prevent fraud or abuse, issue refunds, maintain financial and tax records, resolve disputes, and comply with law.

Customer information is not sold. A customer's identity, work, testimonial, or results are not published without separate recorded permission.

### 3. Service providers

Whop processes checkout, account, payment, receipt, fraud-prevention, dispute, support, and platform data under its own terms and privacy policy. The Seller may use ordinary productivity tools only as reasonably needed to perform and deliver the order, with access limited to the Seller.

### 4. Retention

Transaction, tax, accounting, consent, dispute, and refund records are retained as reasonably required for legal and business obligations. Working intake and delivery files are minimized and deleted or anonymized when no longer reasonably needed, subject to unresolved support, correction, dispute, legal, backup, or recordkeeping needs.

### 5. Customer choices

Customers may request access, correction, or deletion through Whop Chat. Some records may need to be retained for legal, tax, accounting, fraud, refund, or dispute purposes. The Seller may verify a request before disclosing or changing account-related information.

### 6. Security and limits

Reasonable controls limit access and unnecessary collection. No storage or transmission method can be guaranteed completely secure. Customers should provide only information needed for the order.
