

Ataraxia — Terms of Service

1. Agreement to Terms

By checking the agreement box and completing your purchase, you ("the Student") enter into a binding agreement with Zakaria Mahmoud Zaine ("the Architect"), the sole creator and operator of Ataraxia. These Terms govern your access to all platform content. Your purchase cannot be completed without first confirming acceptance of these Terms.

We reserve the right to modify these Terms at any time; material changes will be communicated via email, and continued use of the platform following notification constitutes acceptance.

2. What You Are Purchasing

Ataraxia is a two-phase digital education program delivered through Whop.

Phase I — The Scripture

Upon purchase, you are enrolled immediately into the Ataraxia program, with the 160,000-word written curriculum delivered one lesson per day over approximately 31 days. This daily structure is not a technical limitation — it is the methodology itself. Each lesson is designed to be practiced, observed, and internalized before the next is introduced. Purchasing Ataraxia constitutes full acknowledgment and acceptance of this delivery format.

Phase II — The Codex

A supplementary video intervention of 20+ lessons focused on real-world application. Codex access opens no earlier than 75 days after purchase and is conditional on demonstrated engagement with Phase I, evaluated through the platform's built-in quizzes, open-response exercises, and daily tasks. This is a deliberate sequencing requirement — not an arbitrary delay. Students who engage with Phase I earnestly and in good faith will receive access. Submissions that are visibly incomplete or perfunctory will not meet the threshold. Upon qualifying, Codex access will be granted within 7 business days of the review being completed.

3. Sales Policy

Due to the nature of this product — a structured digital program that begins delivery immediately upon enrollment — all sales are final. From the moment of purchase, you are enrolled, your daily lesson sequence begins, and intellectual property that cannot be returned or recovered is actively being delivered to you. For this reason, we are unable to issue refunds, partial or full, after a purchase has been made.

This includes situations involving:

- The daily drip delivery format

- The 75-day sequential access structure for the Codex
- Personal circumstances arising after purchase
- A decision not to engage with the material
