

Terms of Service

APEX Editors · Effective date: July 2, 2026

1. Who We Are

These Terms of Service (the “Terms”) govern your purchase of and participation in the APEX Editors program (the “Program”), operated by MnsillaSocial OÜ, a private limited company incorporated in the Republic of Estonia, VAT No. EE102636217 (the “Company”, “we”, “us”). Contact: [SUPPORT EMAIL]. Registered address: [REGISTERED ADDRESS, Tallinn, Estonia].

By purchasing the Program through Whop or any other authorized checkout, creating an account, or accessing the Program’s content or community, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not purchase or access the Program.

2. The Program

APEX Editors is an online education and coaching program for video editors. It includes structured video curriculum, templates and digital assets, a private community, weekly Q&A; and mastermind calls, a certification process (the “APEX Certification”), and access to placement opportunities through the APEX Hiring Board and NEXUS Placements network. The Program is delivered digitally; no physical goods are shipped.

We may update, improve, reorganize, or replace individual modules, calls, tools, or community platforms at any time, provided the overall substance of the Program is maintained.

3. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old and legally able to enter into a binding contract to purchase the Program. By purchasing, you confirm that you meet these requirements. The Program is intended for professional and educational purposes.

4. Pricing and Payment

The Program consists of a one-time enrollment fee of \$499.00 USD and an ongoing monthly membership of \$99.00 USD, billed in advance through Whop. Applicable VAT or sales tax may be added at checkout depending on your location. You authorize recurring billing of the monthly membership until you cancel. Failure to keep payments current may result in suspension or removal from the Program.

5. Enrollment Agreement

Your participation may additionally be governed by a separate Client Enrollment Agreement presented at or after purchase. Where these Terms and the Enrollment Agreement conflict, the Enrollment Agreement prevails with respect to the Results Guarantee, refunds, and program-specific commitments.

6. Results Guarantee (Summary)

The Program includes a conditional Results Guarantee: if you complete the eligibility requirements (including obtaining APEX Certification, attending the required number of Q&A; calls, submitting the required video reviews, and actively pursuing client acquisition using the Program's resources) and do not reach \$3,000.00 USD per month in client editing revenue within ninety (90) days of your APEX Certification being approved, you may request a refund of your enrollment fee, subject to the full conditions set out in the Enrollment Agreement.

The Guarantee is forfeited if you decline, or fail to respond within seventy-two (72) hours to, a client opportunity offered to you by the Company through the APEX Hiring Board, NEXUS Placements, or another Company-affiliated channel. The complete and controlling terms of the Guarantee are those in the Enrollment Agreement and the Return Policy.

7. Community Conduct

- Treat other members, staff, and coaches with respect. Harassment, hate speech, spam, and self-promotion outside designated spaces are prohibited.
- Do not solicit, poach, or attempt to divert clients, editors, or agencies introduced through the Program, the APEX Hiring Board, or NEXUS Placements, whether for yourself or for a third party.
- Do not share, leak, resell, or publicly post Program content, call recordings, internal documents, or member information.

Violation of the non-solicitation or confidentiality rules may result in immediate and permanent removal from the Program without refund, in addition to any other remedies available to the Company.

8. Intellectual Property

All Program content — including videos, curriculum, frameworks, templates, presets, LUTs, sound packs, documents, and branding — is owned by the Company or its licensors and is licensed to you, not sold. Your use of Program content is governed by the End User License Agreement (EULA). Nothing in these Terms transfers any ownership rights to you.

9. Cancellation, Departure, and Re-Entry

You may cancel your monthly membership at any time through Whop; cancellation takes effect at the end of the current billing period. If you voluntarily leave the Program, re-entry is not available for twelve (12) months from your departure date, and re-enrollment requires payment of the then-current enrollment fee in full.

10. Disclaimers

Except for the express Results Guarantee described above, the Company makes no promises regarding income, client acquisition, or business results. Any earnings figures or member results shared in marketing or inside the community are illustrative and depend on individual effort, skill, and market conditions. The Program is provided “as is” to the fullest extent permitted by law.

11. Limitation of Liability

To the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, the Company's total aggregate liability arising out of or relating to the Program is limited to the amounts you paid to the Company in the twelve (12) months preceding the claim. The Company is not liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages, including lost profits or lost business opportunities. Nothing in these Terms limits liability that cannot be limited under applicable law, or affects mandatory consumer rights in your country of residence.

12. Governing Law and Disputes

These Terms are governed by the laws of the Republic of Estonia. Disputes shall be resolved by the courts of Estonia (Harju County Court as court of first instance), except that if you are a consumer in the European Union, you retain any mandatory rights to bring proceedings in your country of residence. EU consumers may also use the EU Online Dispute Resolution platform at ec.europa.eu/consumers/odr.

13. Changes to These Terms

We may update these Terms from time to time. Material changes will be announced through the community or by email, and continued participation after the effective date constitutes acceptance. The version in force at the time of your purchase governs that purchase.
