

End User Licence Agreement (EULA)

This End User Licence Agreement (“EULA”) is a legal agreement between you (“User,” “you,” or “your”) and Volkis Ltd, trading as CodeSpring.app (“CodeSpring,” “Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) for the use of the CodeSpring software platform, including all tools, features, templates, boilerplates, generated content, courses, and related services (the “Software”).
