

Privacy Policy for MtnSkyAlgo

Effective Date: March 25th, 2026

This document is an agreement between you and CipherTrades L.L.C., a Texas limited liability company, doing business as 'MtnSkyAlgo' (referred to herein as 'the Company,' 'we,' 'us,' 'our,' 'MtnSkyAlgo,' or 'CipherTrades L.L.C.').

MtnSkyAlgo is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your personal information when you use our services, including our trading course, AI TradingView indicator (Quantum Flow Scanner), all of our trading indicators, all of our tools, all of our software, livestream access, and Discord community. By using our services, you agree to the collection and use of your information in accordance with this policy.

1. Information We Collect

We collect the following types of information:

- **Personal Information:** When you create an account or make a purchase, we collect personal details such as your name, email address, payment information, and any other details necessary to provide our services.
- **Usage Data:** We may collect information about how you access and use our services, such as IP addresses, browser types, and device information. This data helps us monitor and improve our services. This may include metrics related to the AI TradingView Indicator's connectivity, usage frequency, and performance logs to ensure proper service delivery and technical support.
- **Communication Data:** When you contact us through email, support tickets, or other communication methods, we collect the content of your communications along with relevant metadata.
- **Payment Information:** When making a purchase, we collect payment details, though please note that we do not store your full credit card information. Payments are processed securely by third-party payment processors.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use the collected information for the following purposes:

- **To Provide Services:** To deliver the 'MtnSkyAlgo courses, AI TradingView indicator, livestreams, and Discord community membership.
- **To Improve User Experience:** We use data such as usage patterns and feedback to enhance our services and tailor our content to better meet your needs.

- **To Process Payments:** We use your payment information to process transactions securely via trusted third-party payment processors.
- **To Communicate with You:** We may use your email address to send you updates, promotional offers, service-related notifications, and customer support communication.
- **To Comply with Legal Obligations:** We may need to use or disclose your information in order to comply with legal requirements, such as fraud prevention, regulatory inquiries, or as required by law.

3. How We Protect Your Information

We implement appropriate technical, administrative, and physical safeguards to protect your personal information. However, no method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

4. Sharing Your Information

We do not sell your personal information to third parties for monetary consideration. We may share your information in the following circumstances:

- **Service Providers:** We may share your information with trusted third-party service providers who assist us in operating our platform, processing payments, or delivering services. These service providers are contractually obligated to protect your information and use it only for the purpose of providing services to us. Personal and payment information is collected and processed by our Merchant of Record, Whop.com, subject to their own privacy policies.
- **Legal Requirements:** We may disclose your information if required to do so by law or in response to a valid request from a legal authority, such as a subpoena or court order.
- **Business Transfers:** In the event of a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or part of our business, your information may be transferred as part of the transaction.
- **Analytics and Advertising:** We may 'share' identifiers (such as cookies or IP addresses) with third-party analytics providers. Under certain laws, this may be considered 'sharing' for cross-context behavioral advertising, and you have the right to opt-out.

5. Cookies and Tracking Technologies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to monitor activity on our services. Cookies are small data files that are stored on your device and help us improve the functionality of our platform.

- **Cookies:** Cookies are used to remember your preferences, login details, and track user activity to improve the user experience. You can configure your browser to refuse cookies or alert you when cookies are being sent, but note that some parts of the services may not function properly without them.

- **Analytics:** We may use third-party analytics tools, such as Google Analytics, to track and analyze user behavior on our platform. These tools collect information that is used to improve our services and user experience.

- **Non-Discrimination:** We will not deny services or change prices if you choose to exercise your privacy rights.
